

Dear Foreign Secretary

China has introduced new regulations including on the use of evidence obtained through torture. However, the regulations are lacking in detail and critically do not ban outright the use of evidence secured through torture from court proceedings.

In the coalition manifesto the government has committed to '*closer engagement with China, while standing firm on human rights*'. As a supporter of Free Tibet's Stop Torture in Tibet campaign I would like to know what steps the coalition government is taking to ensure that China ends the routine and widespread use of torture in Tibet and China.
